In 1995, he founded **KSD Business Solution**, which he continues to manage to this day. The company began by publishing the monthly magazine **“CHRIMA & TOURISMOS” (Money & Tourism)** and later expanded into the fields of advertising, graphic arts, creative design, communication, exhibition construction, and event organization. The news platform **money-tourism.gr**, which he also founded and curates, is today a leading source of tourism news in both Greece and Europe.

He has organized and moderated dozens of forums, conferences, and thematic panels with the participation of leading politicians, entrepreneurs, and institutional representatives, while remaining an active commentator on current affairs, contributing public interventions on issues of tourism, economy, and institutional governance.

He has attended numerous seminars in the fields of Economics and Entrepreneurship. He is the father of one son.
